7 Day Course on Arbitration 2024

The flagship event of the IMC and its Arbitration Committee

Encouraged by the excellent and continuing response we at IMC have been receiving to the Arbitration Course being organized by our Chamber on an annual basis since the year 2007, we are pleased to announce that this year too, we are organizing our IMC and its Arbitration Committee's flagship program, i.e. the **"7 Day Course on Arbitration"**. This Course is devised organized and conducted by members of IMC's Arbitration Committee, which is headed by its Chair Mr. Gautam T. Mehta (practicing Counsel and Advocate, and Arbitrator and Director of IMC International ADR Centre 'IIAC') and Co-Chair Mr. Bhavesh V. Panjuani (Advocate & Solicitor, and partner of M/s. Mulla & Mulla and Craigie Blunt & Caroe), together with its present Committee members including **Sr. Advocate** Mr. Janak Dwarkadas; **Advocate** Mr. Anant Shende; **Advocates - Counsel** Mr. Kirti Munshi, Mr. Naushad Engineer, Ms. Sneha Phene and Mr. Vyom D. Shah; **Advocates** - Prof. Dr. Ms. Mohana Raje, Mr. Prashant D. Popat (Partner of M/s. ALMT Legal, Bangalore), Mr. Rakesh B. Mandavkar (of M/s. This exhaustive Course on arbitration is conducted over 14 sessions. The Main Speakers at each session comprise of Hon'ble Judges of the Bombay High Court, Senior Counsel and Advocates, having in-depth knowledge and expertise on the subject, who are assisted by Associate Speakers.

This course was initially developed under the guidance of past Arbitration Committee Chairman of several years Late Mr. D. M. Popat (Advocate & Solicitor, and Senior Partner of M/s. Mulla & Mulla and Craigie Blunt & Caroe and the present Co-Chairperson), amongst others; with active assistance of committee members, both past and present.

This Course is of immense knowledge, learning and value to those involved or interested in Arbitration. This year, the 7 Day Arbitration Course is scheduled from **Monday, 11th March 2024 to Monday, 18th March 2024 (Excluding, Sunday)**. The timings are 5.30 p.m. to 7.00 p.m. and 7.15 p.m. to 8.45 p.m. (Monday to Friday); and 10.30 a.m. to 12.00 noon and 12.30 p.m. to 2.00 p.m. (on Saturday) i.e. total 14 (Fourteen) Sessions, 2 (Two) Sessions a day. It is being conducted physically at the venue in the IMC Building at Churchgate, Mumbai, and only those persons residing outside Mumbai can attend the Course virtually / online (through video conferencing on Zoom platform). This year too we have limited the number of participants to maintain standards and quality, and the efficiency of the Hybrid mode.

OBJECTIVE

This Certificate Course is designed to impart a fairly detailed knowledge of various legal and practical aspects of arbitration, including provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, including the 2015, 2019 and 2021 amendments to the Act, in a systematic manner. The Course would also try to cover the current positions as emerging from judgments of Courts.

The thrust of the Government, on a priority, is to encourage and promote ADR (*Alternate Dispute Resolution*) including arbitrations as a preferred mode of resolving disputes and reducing court litigations in commercial matters.

Rapid developments are taking place in India in the fields of Trade, Commerce and Industry resulting in the increase of commercial contracts being entered into by Indian Entrepreneurs within the country, as well as, outside. There has also been a substantial increase in commercial disputes and differences, which parties prefer to be resolved expeditiously, fairly and independently.

Though the Government and the Judiciary are taking several steps for quick dispensation of justice through the Courts of Law, due to a variety of reasons, including large arrears of pending cases and influx of new cases in various Courts, expeditious disposal becomes difficult. The Government and the Judiciary therefore, have taken and are taking various steps to popularize ADR methods for resolving commercial disputes. The Government has also taken steps to encourage and foster a culture of institutional arbitrations in India.

Arbitration, at present, is one of the preferred ADR methods for resolving disputes. However, to make Arbitration successful, effective and economical, there is also an urgent need for Courses in Arbitration, dealing with not only the legal aspects of Arbitration, but also its practical aspects. Recognizing this need, IMC has, for the past several years, taken upon itself the task of creating awareness of Arbitration as one of the useful and effective methods of ADR and, also arranging Seminars, Webinars, Conferences, Workshops and Courses attended and conducted by persons of eminence in the field. IMC as a prominent Chamber of Commerce and Industry has in the past also made representations and submitted papers to the concerned Ministries of the Government in the field of arbitration, amongst others. IMC has also established a modern IMC International ADR Centre (IIAC) at its premises to promote institutional arbitrations.

The Arbitration Course will cover various topics under the following heads:

- Introduction to Arbitration (Advantages of Arbitration, and Institutional vs. Ad-hoc Arbitrations)
- Arbitration Agreement
- Arbitrable and non arbitrable disputes
- Initiation of Arbitration Proceedings and Constitution of Arbitral Tribunal
- Interim Measures and Appeals from Interim Orders
- Powers of Courts (before and during arbitral proceedings)
- Conduct of Arbitration Proceedings
- Hearing of the main matter
- Practical Aspects of conducting arbitration (*pleadings to closure*)
- Decision making
- Post Award matters
- Overview of Part I of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996
- International Arbitration and Foreign Awards (Part II of the Act)

(The Course contents, topics, sequence/ order of the sessions, dates and the Speakers are subject to change, if the circumstances so require, and shall be at the discretion of IMC and its Arbitration Committee in consultation with the Speakers. Study material and papers will be provided to all the participants prior to the respective sessions, if the same is prepared and submitted by the Speakers at their discretion. However, this material is strictly and exclusively for personal use of reference of only the registered participant and is not to be quoted, copied, extracted, circulated, reproduced, disseminated, shared or distributed in part or full, in any manner.)
