During the month of January 2025, 53 tourist visas and 46 business visas were issued by the Mission. Apart from these, 319 tourist E-visas and 55 business E-visa were also issued. Since India launched E-visa services for nationals from Morocco, there is a significant interest for this service from Moroccan tourists and well as businessman visiting India. Indeed, in January 2025, total of e-visa (all categories-wise) issued to Morocco nationals is 381. The cumulative number, for January 2025, of issued visas to Moroccan visitors is **480** (99 by the Consular service and 381 e-visas) largely superior comparatively to the same period last year where 160 visas were issued.
